


# Modern Slavery Charter for Suppliers & Service Providers



**Akura Pty Ltd (Akura) is an Australian based manufacturer and construction business with operations in NSW, Victoria and Queensland.**

Akura has a zero-tolerance approach to all forms of Modern Slavery within its business and is committed to complying with the requirements of The Modern Slavery Act 2018 (Commonwealth) (The Act) and as it applies to all Akura operations and our supply chains.

Modern slavery is a violation of fundamental human rights and can take many forms, the most common being:

Forced labour and forced marriage, deceptive recruiting for labour or services, servitude, Debt Bondage, Human Trafficking, illegally withholding personal documents, I.D's or pay and the sale and/or exploitation of children and vulnerable adults.

These all have the effect of depriving a person of their liberty, for the purpose of exploiting them for personal or commercial gain.

**The Purpose of this Charter**

The purpose of this Modern Slavery Charter for Suppliers and Service Providers (Charter) is to communicate and reinforce Akura's commitment to our zero-tolerance approach to all forms of slavery, servitude and human rights offences. This Charter is consistent with the values and commitments expressed in our Human Rights Policy, our Modern Slavery Policy and our business practices. This Charter has been prepared for all vendors wanting to provide goods or services to Akura. This will include, but is not restricted to, all sub-contractors, consultants and providers of goods and services.

**Our requirements under this Charter**

Akura require that our suppliers and service providers take all reasonable steps to ensure that there are no forms of Modern Slavery within their business or that of their supply chain. Akura requires that all reasonable steps are taken to ensure that their supply chain complies with the requirements of this Charter and their agreement with us.
